International Leader Awards is scheduled to be held on 15th November 2018 at Abu Dhabi where awardees would be felicitated at the glittering Gala night.

About International Leader Awards

The Committee for Members in Industry & Business within the framework of one of its main objectives is organising the **"INTERNATIONAL LEADER AWARDS"** to identify, distinguish and highlight the dedication and outstanding contribution of the members who are based outside India.

The aim of the awards is to recognize the determination and commitment of the professionals who would go the extra mile and contribute in their dynamic domain.



Award Process

- 1. Seeking Nominations:** The entire process will be system driven wherein certain information in the desired format supported by documents evidence will be called from the nominee.
- 2. Scrutiny of the applications:** Preliminary scrutinising of the application would be conducted. Information provided in the nomination form and the supporting documents will be verified by the auditors.
- 3. Selection of Awardee by Jury Panel:** A panel of eminent personalities, dignitaries etc., from various industries or business houses would be formed which will select the Awardee under various categories.
- 4. Honoring Awardee in Award Function:** A gala function would be organised to celebrate the success of the Awardees.

Awards Eligibility Criteria

Nominees must:

- Be a member of ICAI and based outside India
- Nominee should have minimum experience of 3/5/10 years according to the applicant's category
- Nominee should not be holding COP during the minimum experience period being considered as per the applicant's category till the conclusion of award ceremony
- Nomination by the same person in different categories/sub categories will not be considered
